Convocation Ceremony Deadline Dates
 Congratulations on this major milestone! The Sessional Dates in the Graduate Calendar specify the "Final Date to File Theses with Graduate Studies and Complete Degree Requirements" which is when you must upload your final thesis to MacSphere to join the ceremony, Fall or Spring. If you upload your thesis past the noted deadline, for example September 29 for Fall 2023, but prior to the ceremony date (e.g. Fall November Convocation), you are required to email the Associate Registrar at areggrad@mcmaster.ca to request that you join convocation and indicate that you have completed your degree requirements. Should you be approved to join late, your ceremony experience may be impacted.

In addition to the email, you can use the following check box to clearly identify your convocation ceremony preference if you fall into the above mentioned time frame from deadline to ceremony.

Please note: this is **NOT** a deferral of ceremony request. The expectation is that you join the ceremony in which your degree requirements were cleared for. If you were unable to attend your designated ceremony, you must submit a Service Request for the deferral of your ceremony and you should recognize that your degree would have already been conferred at the past ceremony.

Once you have uploaded your FINAL thesis on MacSphere and your completed form has been submitted to the Graduate Administrator for your program, you can be cleared to graduate, provided all other program requirements are complete. From that date on, you are no longer considered an active Graduate student and the tuition balance of the months remaining in the academic year will be refunded.

Please note: Once your thesis is approved and posted to MacSphere, no changes are permitted.
