Two-page attachment

Describe EDI considerations in your research plan, if applicable

Write the proposal yourself

Explain significance of your project

Be clear and specific

Make your proposal clear for reviewers

- Applications containing research proposals that are not eligible under these guidelines may be rejected
- You can only apply to one agency per academic year

Justification of research (optional one page attachment)

- Complete if any overlap with social sciences or health
- Used only by NSERC staff to determine eligibility
- Short explanation why your research fits within NSERC's mandate

Subject eligibility



Part 1: Contributions to research and development

- Articles published, accepted, and submitted only

Part 2: Most significant contributions

- Describe your role in three contributions from Part 1


Part 3: Applicant's statement

- Skills, experiences, and qualities demonstrating your excellence

PGS/CGS D – 2 pages
PDF – 4 pages
